#### 2 News

- The Spanish NGI officially joins the Life Science Grid Community. See updated resource table in the minutes of Oct 6th meeting<sup>1</sup>. The Spanish NGI will organize a training event this summer in Santander. The VRC could participate.

### 3 Representation

- user database (biomed): no progress so far
- Erik Bongcam-Rudlof is the new biomed representative for bioinformatics; his main role is to evaluate the requests for new applications

#### 5 Technical

- Application support. The university of Westminster and MTA SZTAKI provide expertise and support for porting applications. Needs to be better advertised to the community. → advertise these services in your VOs.
- VO operations survey: no progress on this topic yet (Tristan)
- operational procedures
  - sites in maintenance to be flagged in BDII<sup>3</sup>: this seems to be a biomed-specific need; eNMR has no problem with downtimes; vlemed subscribes to the downtime email list and has not much problem because of downtimes, except storage and core services
  - in general eNMR has little reliability issues and has a very high success ratio (software is pre-installed and the platform has some mechanisms for faulttolerance, including timeouts)
- experience with redundant VOMS servers ("Just distribute a second vomses file and a second .lsc file for the new VO."); answer from the Dutch NGI; almost zero downtime in the VOMS server; willing to look into it if the technical part would be simple; could not answer for today; → biomed to look in Greece; Ignacio is also in the core VO service group in NA3; contact point for requesting this to the infrastructure area; preparing some documents on the kind of services that would be provided; these will probably include VOMS service, LFC and WMS.
- updated procedure for SE decommissioning<sup>4</sup> (blocks lcg-cr)
- procedure for full SEs (storage size, discussion with vlemed); to be sorted out with biomed/vlemed: → organize a how-to page for sites

## 6 Training

- Training: requirements and offers; no real progress yet (Silvia)
- training actions starting in the Netherlands ; proteomics ; NGS platform on the LSGRID
- Johan answered EGI's request to contribute to community-specific training in EGI User Forum in Vilnius (MOTEUR+VBrowser training)
- Training is a deliverable in WeNRM, focused on the end users and applications; specific courses in NMR; material may be reused<sup>5</sup>
- Samuel: HealthGrid currently working on training and application porting. → send Material?
